FUND DESCRIPTION

The Vetiva Banking ETF "VETBANK ETF" is an open-ended Exchange Traded Fund managed by Vetiva Fund Managers Limited. The VETBANK ETF is designed to track the performance of the constituent companies of the NGX BANKING Index and to replicate the price and yield performance of the Index.

INDEX DESCRIPTION

The NGX BANKING Index comprises of the top 10 banks listed on the Nigerian Exchange Group ("NGX") in terms of market capitalization and liquidity and is a price index weighted by adjusted market capitalization.

MARKET REVIEW & OUTLOOK

The Banking Index recorded strong m/m performances in January as this sector contributed to the gains recorded by the NGX in January. Most listed lenders showed positive returns m/m, with FIDELITBK being a standout performer, recording a gain of 24.14% m/m. This impressive return may be attributed to 2022 full-year results and speculation surrounding dividend payout expectations.


Looking forward, we expect investors in the Nigerian market to be focused on FY'22 earnings results. The financial performance of companies listed in the market will be closely analyzed to identify potential opportunities for investment, and to provide insight into the underlying trends and drivers of the market. However, investors should also consider the Central Bank of Nigeria's Monetary Policy Committee decision to raise interest rates and its potential impact on the equity market.
